

The picturesque Tianmen Shan (Heaven's Gate Mountain) is a huge rocky gap carved by eons of weather and seasons. It measures 180 feet wide and 430 feet high, and is five miles south of Zhangjiajie in northern Hunan Province, and 800 miles west of the port city of Shanghai.
