



One-way fares on Cabin start at \$85, and it takes about eight night hours. That's city center to city center, and a comparable airline trip isn't that much quicker nor cheaper.

Although the actual in-air flight time is only about two hours, consider getting to and from the airport, parking, security check-in and tarmac delays. The total flying journey takes about the same time as the bus ride. And without the private, stretched-out sleep comfort and California dawn window views.
