

Consider how costly, tedious and tough it is to travel in busy Las Vegas by taxi and bus. If you're fit and rarin' to roam, try wheeling around on a bike. For a 24-hour pass, the cost is just \$8, about half the price of a one-way taxi or Uber ride. A three-day pass is just \$12, and if you'll be in town longer, a 30-day pass is just \$20.
