The gondola ride at the Venetian Resort is another romantic setting. Aboard the colorful boats, you won't be able to kneel down to make a proposal, but you and your beloved will be serenaded by singers of traditional love songs. Instead of the real Venice canalside scenes of palaces and piazzas, you'll glide by some of the most expensive shops in Vegas.

A strange, but intriguing locale to pop the question is Madame Tussaud's Wax Museum: This Vegas version of the world-famous waxworks is also at the Venetian Resort. Bring a camera

with you before you propose. Otherwise, no one will believe that you united or reunited in front of a singing Frank Sinatra or Wayne Newton or a strutting John Wayne, a dancing Britney Spears or a trumpet-playing Louis Armstrong. If you want an absolutely free locale for your proposal, and you want to do it in the hours of a Vegas night, the best places are near the colorful volcano eruption in front of the Mirage Resort and the dancing fountains at the edge of the big lake at the Bellagio Resort. They perform from about nightfall to 11 pm, with ten-minute shows about every 30 minutes.

You'll have to get your lover to the spot at the exact right time, so you can pop the question at the moment the volcano erupts and/or near the fountains as they start their four-story-high water and fire dance.
